Introduction

The Bhaktivedanta Book Trust (BBT) Africa's 6th Annual Conference that was held on the 8th August 2015 at the Playhouse Theatre in Durban, South Africa was an unprecedented event in the history of the African BBT, boasting a record attendance of over 430 local and international conference delegates.

Since 2010, this annual conference has been held in countries such as Kenya, Mauritius and Ghana with host countries seeing significant increases in their book distribution efforts post conference.

This was a landmark year where we also celebrated the 40th Anniversary of Śrīla Prabhupāda's visit to South Africa in 1975, acknowledging the early days and the bright future of ISKCON in South Africa.



Conference Highlights

The aim of the BBT Africa conference was to stimulate discussions in all matters of book production, printing, distribution and translation of Śrīla Prabhupāda's books in African languages with various stakeholders in order to discuss issues relevant to book distribution and publication in their regions, inspiring and cultivating the spirit of team work and *Sankirtana* in order to fulfill Śrīla Prabhupāda's instructions regarding the distribution of books and BTG magazines in Africa.

- highlight opportunities that were available to attract and reach the people of Africa;
- present ways on how BBT Africa can be of service to their various stakeholders;
- highlight BTG opportunities and it's importance in Africa;
- discuss the implementation of effective preaching strategies in order to expand the book distribution network.





One may approach any person and induce him to read Krsna literature so that in the future he also may become a devotee. Such activities are recommended in this verse. Such activities will always remind the devotees of the Lord's lotus feet. By fully concentrating on distributing books for Krsna, one is fully absorbed in Krsna. This is *samadhi*. (SB 10.2.37)
